Don't know how to dispose
of building waste?

The Western Sydney Recycling Directory for Construction and Demolition Waste lists businesses that will reuse, recycle or safely dispose of your building waste.

You must keep tipping dockets to prove your waste was taken to a licenced facility for disposal. Both the owner and transporter of building waste are legally responsible for proving the waste was transported to a licenced facility (Section 143 of the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act*).

Demolition and construction waste must NOT be placed in your waste and recycling bins.

Using skip bins for building waste?

Ensure your skip bin supplier:

- is registered with Blacktown City Council before placing bins on roads, footpaths or in public areas. Ask your supplier to confirm its registration with Council
- gets a Road Occupancy Licence (if it is not registered with Council), before placing bins on a road or footpath, otherwise fines may apply
- removes any waste that has spilled from the bins (it is their responsibility)
- does not place bins in areas where parking, stopping or standing of vehicles is prohibited.

Skip bins must comply with Council requirements, they must:

- be in a good, clean condition
- list the name and phone number of the supplier
- be bright yellow, orange or white if on public roads to improve visibility
- have reflectors or retro reflective tape to improve visibility to oncoming traffic
- have mounted flashing yellow lights in badly lit areas to improve visibility.

Your skip bin must not be used for:

- waste generated by manufacturing or industrial processes (if placed in public areas)
- hazardous waste such as poisonous, toxic or infectious waste (if placed in public areas)
- asbestos. This material must be disposed of in line with NSW SafeWork's requirements.



If your bin does not comply with the above requirements, it is your responsibility to request a compliant one from the supplier. Alternatively, you can refuse delivery of the bin.

If a non-compliant bin is located on Council land, fines may apply to the supplier and you as the hirer.
